EVENTS/FUNDRAISERS

Gently Used Clothing Sale

Takes place during the summer, usually in July or August, so that parents can purchase gently used dress code compliant clothing for their student(s). Volunteers are needed to plan for the event, and then sort and organize clothing prior to the sale and be present for the day of the sale.

Harvest Bingo

This is one of the PA's largest fundraisers, and it takes place in October. Committee help is needed to plan the event. Also, in addition to critical volunteer help during the event, support is also needed in the areas of: tricky tray donations, monetary game sponsorships, and food, beverage and baked goods donations.

Trivia Night

A fun family night for students, parents, and faculty. Form a team and compete against each other in an entertaining trivia game. Committee volunteers are needed for planning the event, lunchtime ticket sales, set-up, and executing the event.

Calendar Raffle

Parents are asked to sell Calendar Raffles, where there is a monetary prize raffled off each day during the month of February. Committee help is needed in early January to prepare the mailing of the calendar chances to MMI families.

Springo Designer Bag Bingo

This is the largest fundraiser, held in the spring. Committee help is needed to plan the event. Also, in addition to critical volunteer help during the event, support is also needed in the areas of: tricky tray donations, monetary sponsorships, and food, beverage and baked goods donations.

ACTIVITIES

Spirit Day & Pep Rallies

The Parents Association often provides snacks during these events. Volunteers may be needed to help plan an event and/or help during the school day to help set up or with snack distribution.

Open Mic Nights

The Parents Association is looking to host several Open Mic Nights during this school year. Open Mic events will serve as a student activity where MMI students can display their talents through performances of skits, poetry, music, etc. Volunteers are needed to serve on the planning committee and may be asked to attend the events as a helper or chaperone.

Harvest Dance

Held in November, the Parents Association sponsors a dance for upper school students. Assistance is needed on the planning committee as well as for decorating, dance set-up, chaperoning, and clean-up.

Founder's Day

Held the day before Thanksgiving break, the Parents Association provides pies and drinks for all students during each lunch period. Volunteers are needed to help set-up and serve food, drinks and dessert.

Making Smart Choices Event, featuring the 525 Foundation

This year, the MMI Parents Association will be hosting a day event for students and an evening event for parents featuring Becky Savage from 525 Foundation. 525 Foundation exists to educate teens and families and raise awareness about the dangers of alcohol and prescription drug misuse and abuse. Students will also have the opportunity to talk and hear from a variety of local agencies that will be on hand, at individual tables in the gymnasium, with important and relatable information. Parent volunteers may be needed throughout the day to assist.

Mid School Dance

Held in February, this Parents Association sponsored dance is for mid-school students. Assistance is needed on the planning committee as well as for decorating, dance set-up, chaperoning, and clean-up.

Teachers' Luncheon

The Parents Association provides a luncheon for teachers one day during teacher appreciation week in May. Volunteers are needed to plan, set-up, serve and clean up the luncheon.

Graduation Reception

Held right after the graduation ceremony, a reception for graduation attendees is served in the cafeteria. Help is needed with planning the event, set-up, and clean up. This event is organized through the Parents Association by the junior class parents.
